All possible classes to this date are listed below. The school schedule is not final. Students are asked to select, **IN PRIORITY ORDER**, the classes they wish to take. Start with YEARLONG courses as choice number two (#2) if you wish to take one. It is important for all middle school students to explore as many subject areas as possible. Eighth grade students should not register for courses completed in 7th grade. Exceptions to the latter statement are students who wish to continue with AVID, Band or Creative Thinking.

German I and Spanish I are taken for a **HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT** and will count toward the DoDDS Foreign Language requirement for graduation. NOTE: The course will have the same rigorous standard requirements as the courses taught at the High School. The grade earned will not be factored into the student's grade point average at a DoD high school.

Students must have at least SEVEN selections. Choice #1 is required; place #2 by your next choice, etc., up to 7 choices.
