

## Return of Students After Illness

SUBJECT: Return of children after illness

Students must remain out of the school for 24 hours for conditions indicated below. Re-admission criteria:

- Fever free from 24 hours after school exclusion for temperature 100F or greater
- No vomiting, or diarrhea for 24 hours
- Chicken pox (Varicella) lesions crusted and dry, at least 5-7 days from onset
- Lice treatment initiated
- Impetigo lesions covered and under care of health care provider
- Conjunctivitis, (pink eye) signs of infection have cleared
- Ringworm covered, under care of health care provider
- Scabies, 8 hours after first prescribed treatment
- Antibiotic treatment initiated 24 hours prior to return

This is in accordance with the Department of Defense Dependent School policy (DoDDs) H.4.6. A health care providers note cannot over-ride DoDDs policy.
